The goals are to create awareness of a serious safety hazard, to encourage the development of multi-agency training and safe operating procedures to safeguard personnel, other motorists and the victims of the original incidents, and to provide for safe, quick clearance of roads and highways to restore normal traffic flow as soon as possible.
